Congratulations to our consortium members, leaders and the participants for an amazing year of results, work and momentum.





Readiness Initiatives

Digital Equity Bill Roundtable

We brought together 50 of business, community and government leaders in a full day workshop, sponsored by 13 organizations. It was kicked off by the Mayor of Bellevue, John Stokes who has on-going provided immense support to Ignite WA and driving business growth for Bellevue. We covered key topics including key public private partnerships and laid the ground work for 2017 Digital Equity Bill Submission to the Washington State Government. In driving our efforts to support the readiness of small business for the digital age, we developed a comprehensive education series for digital readiness for small businesses to focused on accelerating growth. This enable us to jointly conduct seven of these sessions with an overall participation of 500+individuals, representing 300+businesses.



Outreach Initiatives

Public Private Partnerships



Looking Ahead in 2017

Digital Equity Bill Submission

We are working with Department of Commerce and EDC of King County/Seattle to establish WA Small Business job creation scorecard and integrate the program into Economic Gardening initiative.


